SUPPLEMENTAL JUDGMENT AND
DEGREE
(Paragraph 290)

In the above-entitled matter, Notice of Intention to Offer Proof of Completion of Appropriation and Application of Water Appropriated to Beneficial Use, having been filed within the time and in the manner prescribed by law, by the Montague Water Conservation District, and Notice of the Time Set for Hearing said Proof of Completion of Appropriation and Application of Water Appropriated to Beneficial Use having been given by the Clerk in the manner and for the time prescribed by law, and said matter coming on regularly to be heard this day, and Messrs. Tebbe & Correia appearing for and on behalf of said Montague Water Conservation District, and proof of said Completion of Appropriation and Application of Water Appropriated to Beneficial Use having been offered and having been heard and considered by the Court;

The Court finds that the Montague Water Conservation District, organized and existing under and by virtue of the California Irrigation District Act, as amended, has used 2.30 cubic feet per second of water from the natural flow of Little Shasta River, through the Montague Water Conservation District's main canal

1 throughout the entire year, each and every year; that all of
2 said water has been used for industrial, municipal and domestic
3 purposes within the Town of Montague, Siskiyou County, California;
4 that said use has been and is beneficial use of all of said
5 appropriated water; and that the said Montague Water Conservation
6 District has completed the appropriation of water set forth in
7 Paragraph 290 of Paragraph III of the Decree entered December 30,
8 1932, in the above-entitled Court, the extent of said 2.30 cubic
9 feet per second of water for industrial, municipal and domestic
10 purposes within the boundaries of said District, and within the
11 boundaries of the Town of Montague, all in accordance with the
12 provisions of said Decree, the orders of this Court, and the terms
13 of Permit 2581 issued by the Division of Water Resources upon
14 Application 4909 of said District.

15 NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED
16 as follows, to-wit: that the Montague Water Conservation District,
17 organized and existing under and by virtue of the California
18 Irrigation Act, as amended, is entitled to divert from the natural
19 flow of Little Shasta River, through the Montague Water Conservation
20 District's Main Canal, throughout the entire year, 2.30 cubic feet
21 per second, with a priority of February 4, 1926, or as much as said
22 amount of water as said District directly applies to beneficial
23 use for the purposes hereinafter set forth; all of said water to
24 be diverted from said Little Shasta River at a point (designated
25 on Division of Water Right Map as Diversion _____) which bears
26 approximately N. 85°25' E., approximately 1735 feet distant from
27 the South quarter corner of Sec. 26, T. 45 N., R. 5 W., M.D.B.&M.,
28 being within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Sec. 26, and all of said water
29 to be used for industrial, municipal and domestic purposes within
30 the Town of Montague, Siskiyou County, California, and within the
31 boundaries of said Montague Water Conservation District as shown
32 on Permit 2581 on file with the Division of Water Resources,

Department of Public Works of the State of California.
