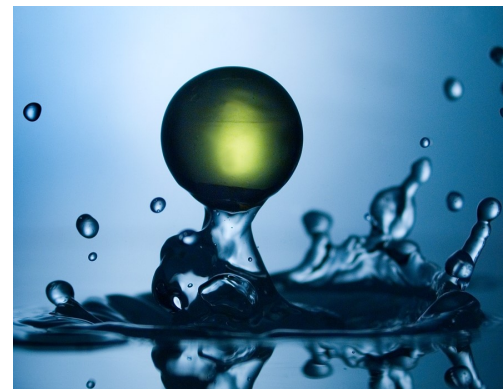

Service Area Boundaries

The District is divided into the Scott Valley Service Area and the Shasta Valley Service Area as previously determined by the Department of Water Resources. However, not all stream systems within a service area are under Watermaster service. Refer to the map included in this publication for an outline of currently served stream systems (aka watersheds).

Water Code section 4000 et seq. authorizes the establishment of service areas to ensure the most practical and economical supervision of the distribution of water within that part of the State. See Water Code § 4025 . Watermaster service areas may be created where water rights have been "ascertained and determined" by any procedure provided by law, including by a court decree, by agreement among water claimants recorded with the County Recorder, and permits and licenses issued subsequent to a decree. Id. §§ 4026-4028.5.

The service areas may be enlarged, reduced, consolidated, or abolished from time to time as convenience of administration may require.

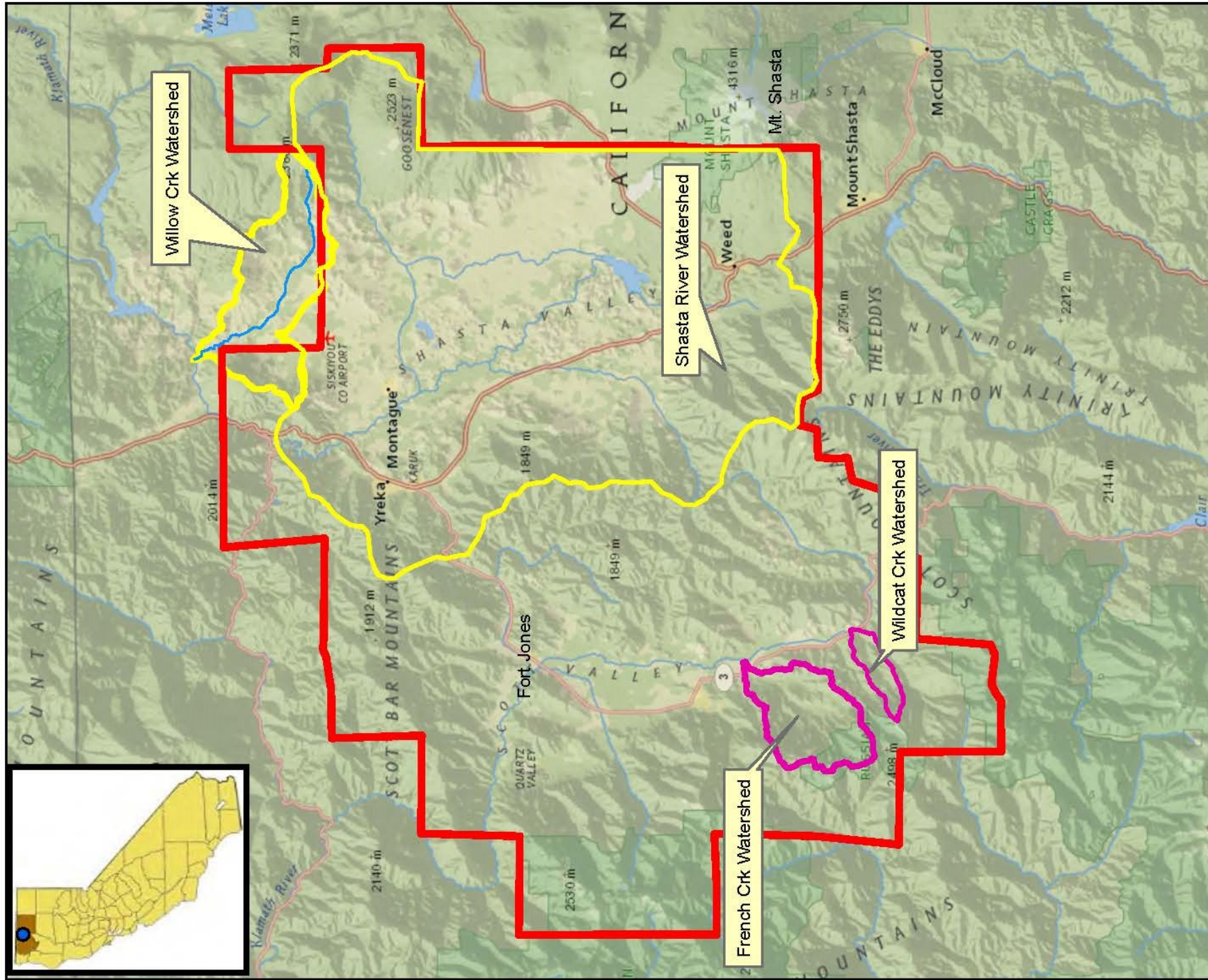
